The Story of Swan Lake





It is a glorious spring evening in the grounds below the Royal Palace. Young Count Benno—the childhood friend of Prince Siegfried—and the prince's two cousins, along with the youth of the court and members of the royal household, join in a celebration of the prince's coming-of-age. Even Siegfried's beloved tutor joins the festivities!

Prince Siegfried, our hero in this tale, is the son of the human King Siegfried XIII and Queen Shailyn who is descended from an ancient race of Fairies. The queen visits the festivities accompanied by her Fairy Attendants. They offer the prince a celebratory dance and the queen presents the prince with his coming-of-age present—a handsome crossbow. This is no ordinary crossbow however! It has been crafted by the ancient Fairies, and is extremely potent against all the evil forces of this world. In times of peace it also serves as an unassuming hunting weapon, perfect for a young prince.

The queen reminds her son that he will soon become King, and as such, he is committed by the laws of the Kingdom to choose his bride the next evening at the Grand Ball. Realizing that the days of his carefree youth are soon over, Siegfried leaves the festivities to seek the solace of the woods and the distraction of game hunting.

ACT II

Later that night, in a moonlit clearing by the lake, the prince sees a swan and takes aim. But before his very eyes, the swan mysteriously transforms into the beautiful Odette! She explains that she is a Queen and she and her maiden attendants have been cursed by the evil sorcerer Von Rothbart (who in his natural state is a creature most resembling a grotesque owl). The spell transforms them into swans by day and allows them only to regain their human form by night. She goes on to reveal that the magic can only be broken by a pledge of eternal love and fidelity by one who has never been in love before. The prince is smitten and vows to save Odette.

Suddenly, Rothbart appears in the clearing and the prince once again draws his bow! But Odette shields the sorcerer's body with hers, not knowing what her destiny and that of her maidens would be should Rothbart be killed before the spell is broken. Rothbart quickly disappears into the woods and Odette withdraws, leaving the astonished prince looking on.

Later that night Odette and the swan maidens seek out Siegfried, and she and the prince spend a joyous night together. As day breaks and the maidens are about to return to the form of swans, Siegfried declares his love for Odette. She in turn promises to find a way to attend the ball at the palace the next evening so he can choose her as his bride. But Von Rothbart, overhearing this final conversation between Odette and Siegfried, has other plans!

ACT III

At the Grand Ball, princesses and their courts arrive from the kingdoms of Hungary, Spain, Napoli, Poland, and Moldova. All are eager to be chosen as the prince's bride and rule this prosperous land by his side, so tensions are high. The turmoil escalates as two sisters-both princesses of Polandarrive separately, surprising each other. It seems that one was sent by the King of Poland, but his wife the Queen had a different opinion and sent the other! Both parents are set on securing their chosen daughter's future as the bride of Prince Siegfried. In addition, the Moldovan King himself accompanies his daughter-such is his fervent desire to form an alliance with this Kingdom. Prince Sieafried beas them to all make peace, and they join together in dance to celebrate the occasion.

But alas, the prince's thoughts are only of Odette. Siegfreid's heart remains unmoved by the lovely princesses and he shares his feelings with his mother. The queen is at her wits' end and can barely disguise her frustration as she apologizes to the princesses, explaining that her son is not yet able to choose his bride!

Suddenly, two uninvited guests arrive. It is Rothbart, disguised as a distinguished nobleman, and his daughter Odile, whom he has transformed into a likeness of Odette. Prince Siegfried is delighted, but after greeting the Royal Court they mysteriously disappear! The prince moves to seek them out, but his mother reminds him of the duties he must fulfill in the ballroom. Each of the princesses in turn attempt to capture the heart of the prince with their national dances. To Siegfreid's great joy, Odile again returns to the ballroom at the behest of Rothbart. She beguiles him and as they dance together the prince becomes increasingly enraptured. When their dance concludes, the prince declares his love for Odile and announces to all that he has chosen his bride! Rothbart guickly demands he swear eternal fidelity and at the very moment he complies. Prince Sieafried sees the real Odette-the woman he truly lovesat the palace window! In a startling moment of clarity, the prince realizes that he is the victim of a heinous plot. He flees the ballroom and rushes to the lakeside in the hopes of finding Odette.

ACT IV

Odette returns to the lake and, with great sorrow, tells the maidens of the tragic turn of events and Prince Siegfried's seeming betrayal. The swan maidens are distraught, as their hopes for freedom have vanished.

A great storm arises as Rothbart, enraged at Odette for thwarting his plans, searches for her among the swans.

When Siegfried arrives at the lakeside and finds the heartbroken Odette, he recounts how he was tricked and begs for Odette's forgiveness. Though she forgives him and expresses her eternal love, Odette explains that with the hope of an earthly union lost, she has no choice but to lay down her life in order to break the spell for her maidens. The prince stops her from this ultimate sacrifice—barring her way to the lake only to have Rothbart appear again.

Rothbart calls on all his evil powers and transforms Odette into a swan without the need of a sunrise. Seemingly destined to remain a swan forever, Odette is compelled by Rothbart's spell to fly away.

As the Prince watches Odette's flight in despair, he finds the strength to fight on in order to protect the maidens from the same fate. The battle is fierce, and it isn't until he's almost exhausted that Siegfried remembers his crossbow which he had laid aside. With renewed hope, he takes aim at the evil sorcerer, and his arrow flies straight and true, through the heart, mortally wounding Rothbart.

The sorcerer falls into the lake to his death as dawn slowly breaks. The sun rises, and the maidens are amazed to see that they have retained their human form. The power of the fairy-crafted crossbow held such a strong antidote to evil that it destroyed not only the villainous Rothbart, but has broken a seemingly unbreakable spell. The maidens bow low to Siegfried both in gratitude but also as they mourn the loss of Odette along with him.

Just then, a swan is seen descending from the sky. As it comes nearer—and to the amazement of all—the swan transforms into the human Odette. The two reunited lovers embrace and joyously journey to the Palace through the morning sunlight.

A great wedding did indeed take place that very day, and not long after, Prince Siegfried ascended the throne as King with Odette as his beloved Queen by his side. But that happy tale will have to be told in another ballet, at another time!


