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The Story of The Sleeping Beauty

Prologue: The Christening

In the Castle

King Florestan the XXIV and the Queen are celebrating the christening of their long awaited newborn daughter Aurora. The good fairies, led by the benevolent Lilac Fairy, have been invited to be godmothers to the little Princess. Upon her they bestow magical gifts, blessing her with every imaginable virtue so that upon her marriage someday, she will be the ideal ruler of the Kingdom. Just as the ceremony is reaching its happy conclusion there is a commotion and Cantalabutte, the King's loyal Minister, announces another arrival! As they check the quest list, Cantalabutte realizes the Squire accidentally (on purpose?) left Carabosse—the one fairy who has turned evil and self-servingoff the list. Would she dare appear uninvited? With a dramatic flourish. Carabosse enters followed by her faithful minions. She exacts her revenge with a curse, declaring that on Aurora's sixteenth birthday the Princess will prick her finger with a spindle and die! The Lilac Fairy quickly intervenes with a spell of her own to avert this tragedy, promising that Aurora will not die, but will instead fall into a deep sleep that will last a hundred years. At the end of that time, a king's son shall awaken her with a kiss. King Florestan is taking no chances however, and immediately forbids all persons in the Kingdom from keeping a spindle, under pain of death!

Brief Musical Interlude

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Act I: The Spell

Sixteen Years Later in the Castle Garden

It is Princess Aurora's sixteenth birthday and princes from the far corners of the world arrive to seek her hand in marriage. Royal friends gather to celebrate the arrival of the suitors and Aurora's long awaited coming-of-age. At the height of the celebration, Carabosse disguises herself and presents Aurora with a spindle as a gift! Unaware of the danger, Aurora dances with this intriguing gift, pricks her finger, and collapses. Believing she has killed the Princess, Carabosse reveals herself in triumph, and then vanishes mysteriously. Just in time, the Lilac Fairy appears and casts a spell of sleep over the entire Kinadom. She commands the Kina and Queen to settle Aurora in her royal sleeping chamber where they too will join her in one hundred years of sleep.

15-Minute Intermission

Act II: The Vision & Awakening A Century Later

Prince Désiré has just dismissed his court and hunting party. He is in a melancholy mood and senses something intriguing about the forest in which he stands. He gets a strange, though not unpleasant feeling that he is about to face a crossroads. Instead of returning to the remainder of his day at court, he decides to linger in the forest to see what it is about this magical place that calls to his heart.



Having long awaited Prince Désiré, who is the one and only perfect prince for Princess Aurora, the Lilac Fairy joyously appears and grants the prince a vision of Aurora's beauty. Naturally, he declares his eternal love for the Princess! The Lilac Fairy leads him to the castle where—under the watchful eve of Carabosse – Aurora, her parents, and the entire Kingdom have slumbered for a century. Together, the Prince and the Lilac Fairy defeat the evil Carabosse! The Prince awakens Aurora with a kiss and the spell is broken. Upon meeting Aurora and her parents, Prince Désiré receives the King's blessing to wed Aurora the very next day!

Act III: The Wedding

In the Transformed Kingdom's Castle

The whole Kingdom celebrates the wedding of Prince Désiré and Princess Aurora. The guests include many fairy tale characters who present their stories as gifts to the royal couple. Prince Désiré and Princess Aurora are crowned with glory, and their reign of light begins.
